If you have been arrested for DUI in Atlanta, Austell, Marietta, Smyrna, Cobb County, Cherokee County, or anywhere in the metro Atlanta area, it is imperative that you consult with a Georgia DUI lawyer to review your case. ### **First DUI conviction:**

- (A) A fine of not less than \$300.00 nor more than \$1,000.00.
- (B) A period of imprisonment of not less than ten days nor more than 12 months, which period of imprisonment may, at the sole discretion of the judge, be suspended, stayed, or probated, except that if the offender's alcohol concentration at the time of the DUI offense was 0.08 grams or more, the judge may suspend, stay, or probate all but 24 hours.
- (C) Not less than 40 hours of community service.
- (D) Completion of a DUI Alcohol or Drug Use Risk Reduction Program.
- (E) If the defendant is sentenced to a period of imprisonment for less than 12 months, a period of probation of 12 months.
- (F) Undergoing a clinical evaluation and, if indicated by such evaluation, completion of a substance abuse treatment program.

### **Second DUI conviction:**

- (A) A fine of not less than \$600.00 nor more than \$1,000.00.
- (B) A period of imprisonment of not less than 90 days nor more than 12 months. The judge shall probate at least a portion of such term of imprisonment, provided, however, that the offender shall be required to serve not less than 72 hours of actual incarceration;
- (C) Not less than 30 days of community service;
- (D) Completion of a DUI Alcohol Risk Reduction Program.
- (E) Undergoing a clinical evaluation and, if indicated by such evaluation, completion of a substance abuse treatment program; and
- (F) A period of probation of 12 months.
- (G) Ignition Interlock on your vehicle for six months, publication of your picture in the

legal notices in the legal organ of the county in which such person resides or, in the case of nonresidents, in the legal organ local newspaper and surrender of any license tag to any vehicle in your name.

**Third or subsequent DUI conviction:**

(A) A fine of not less than \$1,000.00 and not more than \$5,000.00.

(B) A mandatory period of imprisonment of not less than 120 days nor more than 12 months. The judge shall probate at least a portion of such term of imprisonment the offender shall be required to serve not less than 15 days of actual incarceration;

(C) Not less than 30 days of community service;

(D) Completion of a DUI Alcohol or Drug Use Risk Reduction Program.

(E) Undergoing a clinical evaluation and, if indicated by such evaluation, completion of a substance abuse treatment program, and,

(F) A period of probation of 12 months.

(G) Ignition Interlock device on your vehicle for six months, publication of your picture in the legal notices in the legal organ of the county in which such person resides or, in the case of nonresidents, in the legal organ local newspaper and surrender of any license tag to any vehicle in your name.

**Fourth or subsequent DUI conviction** after July 1, 2008, is subject to FELONY punishment of one to five years incarceration of which all but 60 days of imprisonment may be suspended and sixty days of community service in addition to other punishments.
